## Infrastructure

This year We also introduced a grade name board display for each Classes Which helps to maintain order and discipline.

## Board exam results:

Our first batch created history with 100% success rate .The top rank was secured by **D.S. Benitta Sherin** with **96.4%**, followed by **Suvetha D.K.** with **95%**, and **Angelin Vincy** with **94%**. In total, **14 students scored above 90%**, and another **14 students scored above**

**80%**. This success was possible because of the constant support of our **respected Correspondent Rev. Fr. Vinu Kumar**, our **beloved Principal Rev. Sr. Anet Augustine**, dedicated teachers, our **hardworking students**, and **supportive parents**.

Moreover, our management organized **orientation sessions** conducted by **well experienced educators**, and the **guidance of teachers** helped students achieve excellent results, making our school one of the most successful institutions in this locality

### **Cabinet election :**

### **Competitions:**

We regularly organize a variety of school-level competitions such as elocution, rangoli, dance, fancy dress, spell bee, quiz, debate, storytelling, and handwriting contests throughout the year. Our students also participated in inter school, zonal, district, state level and brought laurels to our school. These events ensure that every child gets an opportunity to participate and showcase their talents.

### **Sports day:**

This year the highly anticipated **Sports Sparta 2025–26** was celebrated with great enthusiasm on **October 24**. The event was inaugurated by **Mrs. Viji Kala, Sub-Inspector of Police**, who lit the Olympic torch and released doves as a symbol of peace and sportsmanship.

The celebration began with the **1,500-meter dash**, setting an energetic tone for the day. Abhi Francilin of standard XII is qualified for state level boxing Competition. Our students

participated in the Sports events conducted by Dakshin Sahodaya and our senior throw ball team won second prize . Our super Senior Basketball team participated in the CM trophy and qualified for semi final.

## **Celebrations:**

## **Extra curricular activity:**

We offer a variety of programs such as **music, dance, yoga, karate, guitar, keyboard, drums, chess, skating, and drawing** — all guided by dedicated trainers who help students explore and develop their skills.

We also provide **Abacus training from Grades 1 to 6**, which enhances students' mental and Vedic mathematics abilities. These activities help in shaping a well-rounded personality and building confidence in every child.

## **KG activities:**

We follow activity-based playful learning in our KG section. We celebrate *Colours Day, Fancy Dress, and Role Play* to make learning joyful. We conduct celebrative assembly by KG kids through which every child will get the chance to expose their talents Especially this year, we opened a new kids park — an *indoor activity room*. It provides our little ones a space to learn through fun, play, and energy-filled moments.

## **House activities:**

Our four houses — **Red , Blue , Green , and Yellow**— compete enthusiastically in every activity.

We also conduct a **Notice Board Competition**, where each house prepares **creative displays** on topics such as **science, festivals, inventions, and current events**.

The **house that performs the best** receives awards and points from our **Principal**, which motivates everyone to work harder and participate with enthusiasm.

## **Best class award:**

Every month we present a **Best Class Award**. Classes are judged on **discipline, cleanliness, punctuality, classroom decoration, and academic performance**. The winning class receives a **trophy**, which encourages **teamwork, responsibility, and good habits**.

## **Health and hygiene:**

### **Field Trip and excursions:**
